## Session Styles

Face to Face	Remote	Independent
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Synchronous</li> <li>Small group</li> <li>50 minutes/session</li> <li>2 interactions/week (40%)</li> <li>1 interaction/week (20%)</li> <li>Interactions may occur before or after remote sessions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Synchronous</li> <li>full group</li> <li>60 minutes/session</li> <li>1 interaction/week (40/20%)</li> <li>2 sessions/cycle (40/20%)</li> <li>Interactions may occur before or after face to face sessions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Asynchronous / At home</li> <li>Students need to be able to start on this independently / prior to face to face or remote sessions</li> <li>3 sessions/week (40%)</li> <li>4 sessions/week (20%)</li> <li>50 minutes/session</li> </ul>

## Design Considerations

Design Considerations		
Face to Face	Remote	Independent
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Consider using the same cohort groups as small groups within the remote sessions to build community (Connection)</li> <li>Design desk/table orientations that promote peer support and dialogue eg. circle/ horseshoe</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Embed opportunities to promote social interactions and build community (Connection)</li> <li>Incorporate small groups opportunities for discussion and problem solving (Collaboration)</li> <li>Chunk time/activities by using different technology tools/tasks such as Padlet <a href="https://padlet.com/">https://padlet.com/</a> or Mentimeter <a href="https://www.mentimeter.com/">https://www.mentimeter.com/</a> to maintain engagement</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Post weekly schedule before Monday at 8:30am</li> <li>Provide articles to read, videos to view and any questions to be discussed prior to remote meetings</li> <li>Incorporate on-line discussion boards to answer questions and address misconceptions (Clarification)</li> <li>Provide choice in content to explore and assessment tasks to show understanding, knowledge &amp; skills,</li> <li>Incorporate inquiry questions and visible thinking routines (Critical and Conceptual Thinking at Project Zero <a href="http://www.pz.harvard.edu">http://www.pz.harvard.edu</a>)</li> </ul>
